New business	 Grade 5 ELA Trade Books purchase: Shannon Alm Shannon shared that students need more background knowledge and the ELA teachers are requesting funds to purchase the books that CKLA recommends as a supplement to read aloud to the students. The topics are challenging, and the students do not have all of the background knowledge on these topics. They are requesting one set of books for each unit that the three ELA teachers will share. There are 9 units in CKLA at the 5th grade level, and the books will cost a little less than \$700 for all of the units. There are approximately 5-8 books per unit. Juli motioned to approve getting all of the books for the units all at once for 5th grade. Meghan and Rebeca seconded it. All approve! Juli also motioned to approve \$700 for 6th grade for supplemental books. Rebeca, Tina, and Ashley seconded! All approve! Rebeca recalls getting teachers from Barry to make a little wish list, and then PTO can fund it. She will look for the form that she used to use which helps to keep a paper trail of items purchased. Then the parents can see the benefit of participating in fundraising and see what the funds are used for Fundraising ideas: John from the Chevy program (Royal Motor Group) would like to donate \$500, asked about a list of events to come to, take pictures with the kids and present
